Advertising Policy

The AMS will accept tasteful and accurate advertisements for products and services of professional interest to AMS members from organizations that are actively involved in the atmospheric and related sciences. The AMS also accepts advertising from organizations that have an interest in the atmospheric and related sciences and services, but are not actively involved in them. These organizations may promote their contributions to AMS activities and other good works, but may not directly promote products or services. The AMS reserves the right to refuse advertising that does not meet these criteria. Acceptance of advertising does not constitute the Society's endorsement of the product or service being advertised.

Advertising Rates

Black and White

Cover 4 (\$1365); Covers 2 or 3 (\$1260); Page One (\$1260); One Page (\$1180); One-half Page (\$735); One-quarter Page (\$460); Two-page Spread (\$2470); Digital BAMS Animations (\$190 per file).

Color

4-color advertisement* (\$1450 per insertion)

*Color charge is in addition to the above listed black and white rates. (A 25% discount is available to sustaining, regular, and small business corporation members of the AMS.)

Classified Ads

Line ads for products, services, or employment are \$50 per 50 words. Each additional word is \$1.

Frequency Advertising

There is a 15% discount for 12 consecutive months of advertising; a 10% discount for 6 months within a calendar year; and a 5% discount for 3 months within a calendar year.

Ad Materials

BAMS is printed on an offset press. Ad materials may be provided in any of the following forms: 1) camera-ready copy; 2) .pdf file; 3) .eps file. Electronic files (.eps) are preferred, with color ads saved in CMYK format (RGB is *not* acceptable) and fonts converted to outlines or paths. Nested fonts or graphics must be sent with all ads. 4) Flash files for animations in Digital BAMS (no larger than 5 MB).

Closing Dates and Cancellations

The monthly deadline for advertising insertion orders is the 15th of the month two months prior to month of issue; that is, advertising insertion orders for the April issue must be received by 15 February. Deadline for ad copy is the 22nd of the month two months prior to month of issue. Cancellations are not accepted after closing date of orders.

Ad Design Services

The AMS provides typesetting, layout, and design services for clients advertising in the Bulletin. Fees for design services are \$50 for a one-quarter-page ad, \$100 for a half-page ad, and \$175 for a one-page ad.

Market of BAMS

BAMS (published since 1920 and issued monthly) features editorials, survey articles, conference summaries, and correspondence devoted to the latest news and research in the atmospheric and related oceanic and hydrologic sciences. It also includes professional and membership news and announcements, book reviews, meeting programs, and a professional directory. Special Issues

SEPTEMBER: Scholarship/Fellowship Issue - This issue includes a listing of scholarship and fellowship recipients. Along with AMS, leading environmental science and service corporations, government agencies, and members support the scholarships and fellowships.

NOVEMBER: Meeting Program Issue - This issue includes a synopsis of conferences and symposia being offered at the upcoming Annual Meeting as well as information on activities and programs of general interest. It is used as an itinerary and meeting planner for AMS members and meeting participants.

Professional Directory

The Professional Directory is divided into two sections: the first section is for Certified Consulting Meteorologists, and the second section is for AMS members (professional members). Copy should read like a professional card, not like an advertisement. Space allotted is 1 1/2" x 3 1/4". The rate for insertion is \$31.00 per block, per issue (accepted on a calendar-year basis). Listee is billed automatically at the end of the year for the following year. There is a \$25 charge for changes or corrections. (Sample shown below.)
