AMS PUBLICATIONS PARTNERS WITH KUDOS

Move provides tools for authors to manage research dissemination and impact

JANUARY 9, 2018 – AUSTIN, TX – The American Meteorological Society (AMS) announced that it has signed a multiyear contract with [Kudos](#), the award-winning service for maximizing the reach and impact of research publications.

Kudos provides authors with free tools for sharing plain language summaries of their journal articles. Authors with a Kudos account will be able to measure their articles' impact by tracking clicks, views, downloads, citations, and alternative metrics to learn which communication channels are most effective and view the results in one place.

A shareable PDF of their plain language summary and a link to the official published article online will also be provided to share on external scholarly networks in lieu of the copyrighted article itself. Configuration and implementation of this exciting service is being planned for the first quarter of 2018.
