

2018 American Meteorological Society (AMS) Graduate Fellowship Application & Guidelines

AMS fellowship recipients will be invited to attend the succeeding AMS annual meeting as part of receiving the graduate fellowship funding for your education, with travel and hotel expenses covered by AMS.

Eligible students must be:

- entering their first year of graduate school in the fall of 2018 and provide evidence of acceptance as a full-time student at an accredited U.S. institution at the time of the award.
- pursuing a degree in the atmospheric or related sciences.
- have a minimum grade point average of 3.25 on a 4.0-point scale.
- must be U.S. citizens or hold permanent resident status. No age restriction exists.

The Society encourages applications from women, minorities, and disabled students, traditionally underrepresented in the atmospheric and related oceanic and hydrologic sciences.

Evaluation and Selection Process:

The evaluation of applicants will be based on applicant's performance as an undergraduate student, including academic records, recommendations, and Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) scores. Selection will be made by the AMS Executive Committee. The AMS does not prepare written evaluations of either successful or unsuccessful candidates.

Stipend:

A \$25,000 stipend will be presented to each fellowship recipient for a nine-month period in the 2018/2019 academic year. In addition, fellowship recipients will receive partial travel support to attend the AMS Annual Meeting.

Application Instructions:

Applicants must complete all 6 sections of the application and provide three written references, official transcripts and GRE score reports (call ETS to request GRE scores at 866-473-4373). All applications must be received or postmarked by the deadline date of 12 January 2018. Supporting materials may arrive up to 2 weeks after the application deadline (e.g. referrals, transcripts). Please submit one application, either electronically or by mail.

Submission of Application Materials: (To keep the evaluation fair for all, additional documents will not be considered e.g. curriculum vitae)
